XI.	MISCELLANEOUS. The Photographer and the Client hereby agree to the following

- **XI.** MISCELLANEOUS. The Photographer and the Client hereby agree to the following terms:
 - a. Independent Contractor. The Photographer is recognized as an independent contractor under this Contract, maintaining their own independent business and utilizing their own tools and equipment to fulfill the obligations specified.
 - b. Taxes. The Photographer is solely responsible for any taxes arising from the provision of their services under this Contract.
 - c. Important Moments. The Client must communicate any significant moments at the Wedding to the Photographer with adequate notice.
 - d. Photographer's Actions. The Client and all guests acknowledge that the Photographer's actions are contingent upon the Client's communication.
 - e. Additional Services. Any requests for additional services ("Additional Services") must be made by the Client in writing and may be declined by the Photographer if such requests are deemed impossible or inconvenient. If a request for Additional Services is accepted, the Client agrees to cover all associated fees charged by the Photographer.

- f. Equipment Damage. The Client will be held accountable for any damage or loss to the Photographer's equipment arising from misuse or theft by the Client or their guests, as well as in the event of a force majeure occurrence (which includes, but is not limited to, fires, floods, severe weather, and earthquakes).
- g. Liability and Indemnification. The Photographer shall not be liable for any direct, indirect, incidental, or consequential damages (including, but not limited to, losses related to profits or increased expenses) concerning any claims associated with this Contract and the Services rendered. The Client agrees to indemnify and protect the Photographer and any subcontractors from all liabilities related to the Client's Wedding from the date of the event and into the future. The Client will cover all legal expenses claimed by third parties, provided that such losses or damages were not caused by the fault or negligence of the Photographer or their employees, agents, or subcontractors. Additionally, the Photographer reserves the right to cancel the Services outlined in this Contract at any time and without notice, bearing no liability or obligation to the Client beyond the refund of any Deposit or advance payments made by the Client.
- XII. SUBSTITUTION. In the event of illness or scheduling conflicts, the Photographer may replace themselves with another equally skilled photographer. The Client will be notified as soon as possible in such cases.
- **XIII. WATERMARKS** All images displayed with watermarks or in preview mode will have these limitations removed upon full payment to the Photographer.
- COPYRIGHT. The Photographer retains nonexclusive, irrevocable, perpetual, and international rights to use, publish, crop, modify, reproduce, and distribute any photos taken at the wedding in print and through all other formats, methods, and technologies of distribution, both existing and future. Consequently, it is strictly prohibited for the Client to modify, copy, or reproduce the photographs without the Photographer's written consent, except for personal use.
- **XV.** ORIGINAL PHOTOS. It is agreed that the Photographer will be the sole owner of all photos captured at the wedding unless a different arrangement has been made.
- XVI. PHOTOGRAPHER'S CANCELLATION. If the Photographer must cancel services due to circumstances beyond their control, all payments made by the Client will be refunded, and the Photographer will not be held liable for any legal or financial repercussions.
- XVII. SEVERABILITY If any provision of this Agreement is found to be void, invalid, unenforceable, or illegal for any reason, that provision shall be rendered null and void; however, the remaining provisions of this Agreement will remain unaffected and continue to be valid and enforceable.
